- Below is a list that we will be working on in no particular order.

1. The freezer in South kitchen storage area needs to be moved to the North kitchen
2. Clean both kitchens
3. Trim trees and other general yard maintenance, possibly including spreading mulch around trees in park
4. Clean bathrooms
5. Clean storage sheds at both diamonds
6. Clean garbage cans – could use a pressure washer for this project
7. Backfill dirt around newly poured concrete in front of dugouts at North diamond
8. Possible diamond work at North diamond – reposition of base pegs and foul line work, could use a tiller for this project
9. Move flower pots located around the park to the North park pavilion next to soda machines
10. Pick up garbage throughout the park – this is a good “kid” project

There will be several Community Development members around to assist in organizing everybody but otherwise pick a project, pick some help and get busy!
